

Australia Student Visa Documents Checklist & General Information

Entry Points, Entry Requirements, and Costs

To be admitted to an Australian university, students must meet the required level of English language proficiency and the minimum academic standards.

- **Undergraduate:** Year 12 or an equivalent. Some degrees may also require specific subjects and grades.
- **Postgraduate:** Requires a completed bachelor's degree. Additional requirements may include research ability or relevant work experience.

Documents Required for Application

Offer Letter

- Academic documents up to date
- IELTS/TOEFL score
- Passport
- Work experience (if any)
- University/College application form
- Skype/phone interview (may be required)
- Offer letter processing time: 1 to 6 weeks

Visa Documentation

- All academic documents (Transcript, Provisional, Character certificate)
- 2 recent passport-size color photos with a white background
- IELTS/TOEFL score
- Financial documents (Educational loan from Nabil or SBI bank to cover 1-year tuition and living costs or a 3-month-old bank balance statement with evidence of income)
- Income sources with supporting documents
- Valuation of property with supporting documents
- Tax clearance certificate
- CA report
- Relationship certificate with sponsors and family members
- Birth certificate
- Police report
- Citizenship certificate (translated in English)
- Confirmation of Enrollment (CoE) from the university
- Statement of Purpose (SOP)

Additional Documents (for Spouse)

- Marriage certificate
- Evidence of cohabitation

- Joint financial assets or liabilities (e.g., joint property or bank accounts)
- Evidence of relationship (photos together, statements from family/friends)
- Loan to cover dependent's living and travel costs (AUD 6,515 per year + AUD 2,000 for travel)

Visa Application

- 157A Visa application form
- Visa application charge (Demand Draft)

Dependent Visa

- Can be applied for at the same time as the student visa.(Condition applied)

Visa Information

- **Visa Type:** Student visa
- **Method of Teaching:** English
- **Interview:** May be conducted By Australia visa officers(Needs to prepare well)
Intakes: February and September for universities; private colleges may have flexible intakes.

Estimated Expenses

- **Tuition Fee:** AUD 18,000 to AUD 22,000 for 1 year
- **Pocket money:** AUD 2,000
- **Air Ticket:** AUD 700
- **Total Approximate Expenses:** AUD 15,000 to AUD 18,000 (NPR 15 to 18 Lakhs)
